



Examples

Marina took a trip to Washington, D.C., with her high school class. She visited the Air and Space Museum and touched a rock from the moon.

- ▶ **Marina's H.S. trip—Washington, D.C., visited the Air and Space Museum, rock from moon.**

Jim loved to play sports when he was in high school. In his senior year, he was the pitcher for the baseball team.

- ▶ **Jim—H.S., loved to play sports, senior year, pitcher—baseball team.**
